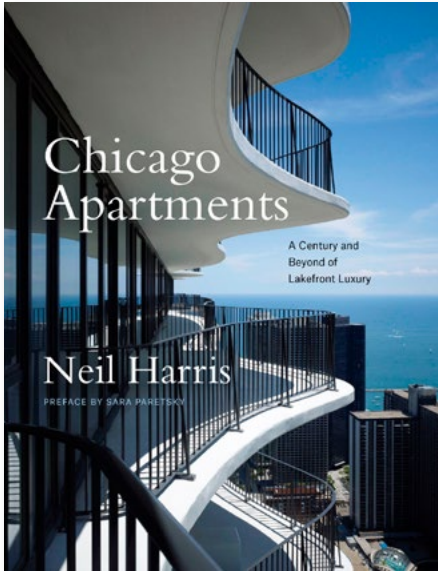


## Neil Harris on “Chicago Apartments: A Century and Beyond of Lakefront Luxury,” via Zoom
